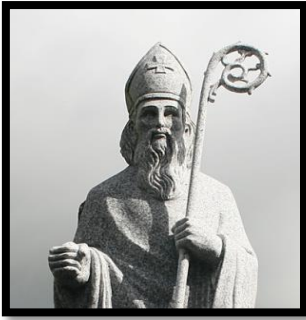

SANCTUARY RESTORATION: Phase two is now here!!! On *Monday, January 7th* we will be moving out of the church after the 8:00am Mass at St. Patrick’s in order to complete phase two of the restoration of the church. For the next two months we will have Mass and adoration in the parish hall. After the expenses of phase one, we have **\$9,805.00** to begin phase two. Please continue to be as generous as you can be, using the **green envelopes** marked “*Sanctuary Restoration*”. The projects and estimates for phase two are as follows:

1. Marble and wood niches and high altar: \$10,000.00
2. Pew restoration (including new pads): \$13,500.00
3. Cleaning, priming and painting ceiling: \$7,500.00
4. Flooring in the church, narthex and conference room: \$\$\$?
5. Sound proof and refurbish the interior of confessional: \$1,500.00
