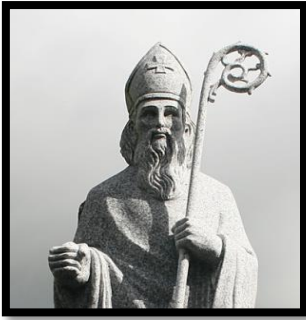

As you know, it is a custom to make a New Year’s resolution in order to improve our lives in some way. As I said in my Christmas homily, let’s not make the resolution to lose weight ☺. Instead, I am asking all of us to make the New Year’s resolution to **center our lives on Jesus in the Eucharist**. During this “Year of the Eucharist,” we are asking our Blessed Mother at the end of each Mass to help us center our lives on Jesus in the Eucharist. Each of us has to determine what that means for ourselves. It might mean more faithful Sunday Mass attendance. It might mean going to Mass an extra time during the week or as often as we can. **MASS INTENTIONS:** We are in need of **more** Mass intentions for our three parishes. If you would like to have a Mass offered for someone living or deceased or for a special intention please use the **Mass intention envelopes** that are available in the narthex. Thanks!

**SANCTUARY RESTORATION:** Phase two is now here!!! On *Monday, January 7<sup>th</sup>* we will be moving out of the church after the 8:00am Mass at St. Patrick's in order to complete phase two of the restoration of the church. For the next two months we will have Mass and adoration in the parish hall. After the expenses of phase one, we have **\$8,805.00** to begin phase two. Please continue to be as generous as you can be, using the *green envelopes* marked "*Sanctuary Restoration*". The projects and estimates for phase two are as follows:

1. Marble and wood niches and high altar: \$10,000.00
2. Pew restoration (including new pads): \$13,500.00
3. Cleaning, priming and painting ceiling: \$7,500.00
4. Carpeting the church, narthex and conference room: \$\$\$ ?
5. Sound proof and refurbish the interior of confessional: \$1,500.00
